

How can I begin an eSCM Assessment?

Step 1: Log on to www.escm.org.sg

Determine how your company can benefit from this programme and where you stand in the industry. You can have a feel of the assessment by completing the interactive online questionnaire.

Step 2: Obtain management approval to undergo an assessment.

Step 3: Request for an audit.

You can request for an audit online or by calling us at (65) 6826 3016 / 03. SCI will then schedule an independent audit on your preferred dates.

Step 4: Undergo an Internal Assessment and collect of KPI data.

Step 5: Undergo a two day audit and workshop conducted by an independent auditor.

Step 6: Receipt of report highlighting key findings and improvement opportunities.

Step 7: Benchmark your company's opportunities against the industry standards.

The **eSCM Assessment Programme** addresses key areas of collaboration and exchange of information within the Supply Chain including:

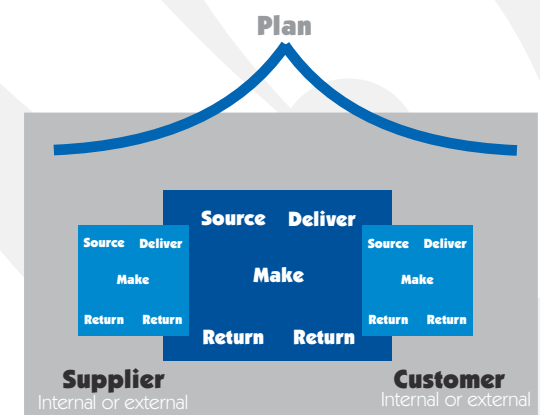
- * Collaborative forecasting and planning
